Dear NorthWood Football Parents,

Greetings to you all! The school year is quickly coming to a close and we are preparing for the 2015 football season. There are a few dates we want to highlight for you so you can be as informed as possible as we head into our summer schedule. **First and foremost, there is a parent information meeting for parents of all high school football players next Thursday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30pm in the NorthWood High School Cafeteria.** We understand that there is a conflict with the middle school track meet, but hope parents of track athletes will be able to make it to the high school for the end of the meeting. For these two nights the high school and middle school coaching staffs will be coming together on Doc Able Field at NorthWood Middle School to instruct boys in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade on the basics of NorthWood Football. May 20<sup>th</sup> is also our athletic physical day. Your son will be able to get his athletic physical completed for the upcoming school year for a cost of only \$25. There will be a special activity bus taking players from the middle school practice to the high school for physicals on this night. This is a great opportunity to get a jump on the paperwork for next year at an affordable cost. Lastly, we want to make you aware of this year's team camp which will take place July 16-18 at Trine University. This will be a great opportunity for your son to take part in building our program. There will be many team building activities and it will be a beneficial few days for your son as we will introduce many of the concepts that we will be implementing during fall camp.
